## **EDUCATION CLASS**

OVF Education will present a class on Saturday March 25 at 10 AM: Introduction to Drip Irrigation. Learn how drip irrigation works and explore the advantages of drip and other slow water methods. Learn how you can save time, save water and improve your plants' health with drip irrigation. Bring your questions and curiosity to this fun and informative class.

Two experienced OVF members will teach the class. Amy Smith is a licensed Landscape Architect. Les Hairrell is a Master Gardener and has certificates from UCLA in Landscape Architecture and Horticulture.

The class will include a 'show and tell' of all things drip, including an operating demonstration drip system, all the drip parts, and educational materials, including pamphlets and catalogs. There will be a raffle of water related prizes. After the class, we'll go on a field trip into the garden to see working drip systems in member plots.
